


GENERAL INFORMATION

All electrical connections must be in accordance with all ordinances,
Local and National Electrical Codes. These fixtures are intended for
mounting to a standard 4" x 2 1/2"metal octagon outlet box. The box
must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L. Recognized.

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting your installation disconnect the Power by turning off the Circuit Breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.



MOUNT CROSSBAR

If there is an existing fixture remove it. Expose the supply wires from the j-box. Mount the supplied crossbar to the j-box with the supplied screws.



CONNECT THE WIRES

Gently pull the supply wires. Connect the black fixture wire to the black supply wire and the white fixture wire to the white supply wire.

Connect the fixture ground wire to the ground wire from the j-box.

Secure all connections with the supplied wire connectors and U.L listed electrical tape (not supplied). Tuck all wires carefully into the j-box.



MOUNT THE BACK PLATE

Insert the nipple into the central hole of the crossbar, and adjust to suitable length. Fasten the hex nut against the nipple so that the nipple will not rotate further. Position the back plate against the wall, make the nipple pass through the center hole of the back plate, then secure with the supplied decorative cap.

NOTE: This fixture has been certified for <u>Wet Location</u>, and it is for outside applications. Therefore, as to reduce the risk of electrical shock, it is strongly recommended that a silicone caulking be utilized to provide a watertight seal between the fixture and its mounting surface.





INSERT THE BULB

Insert the bulb.

DO NOT EXCEED THE RECOMMENDED WATTAGE AS STATED ON THE WARNING LABEL AND INSTRUCTION SHEETS.


